NEW TRAVEL RESTRICTION

UNDER INTERNATIONAL HEALTH REGULATION (IHR 2005)

World Health Organization has declared polio as "Public Health Emergency" with Pakistan Syria and Cameroon identified as posing the risk of exploration of virus beyond their borders. In this regard, following guidelines (and attached brief about the disease) are issued for the awareness for public.

1. All travelers proceeding abroad must be vaccinated for polio.
2. All residents and visitors staying for more than 04 weeks in Pakistan should receive polio vaccination.
3. At airports, only those, who are undertaking urgent travel will be vaccinated.
4. All DHQ,s teaching hospitals MS and other tertiary hospitals will provide this facility.
5. An international certificate of vaccination / prophylaxis as per IHR (05) will be issued after vaccination.
6. Vaccination 04 weeks prior to travels except as per Para 3, this certificate remain valid for the year.
7. Polio vaccination counter is operational w.e.f. 10-05-14 at AIIAP in the international departure area.

This certificate must be signed in the field of the clinician who shall be a medical professional or other authorized health worker, supervising the administration of the vaccine or prophylaxis. The certificate must also bear the official stamp of the administering centre. However, this shall not be an accepted substitute for the signature.

Any amendment of this certificate, or failure to complete any part of it, may render it invalid

The validity of this certificate shall extend until the date indicate for the particular vaccination or prophylaxis. The certificate shall be fully completed in English or in French. The certificate may also be completed in another language on the same document, in addition to either English or French.
